We are having our General Election Meeting in October. Between now and then, we're seeking candidates interested and willing to serve on our Board of Directors.

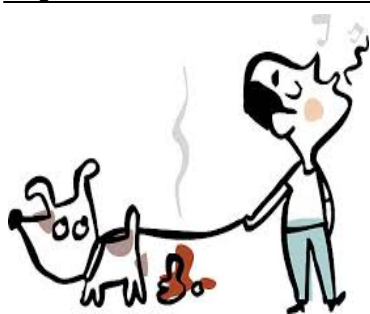
